The Wollaston Certificate in Theology

[The Certificate](#) is an introductory academic course that allows students to explore foundational areas of Christian faith such as Biblical Studies, Doctrine and Church History, as well as offering a range of electives including Ethics and Liturgy. The Certificate comprises eight units: four core and four elective units.

[The Certificate](#) offers an excellent introduction to Christianity and the Anglican Church. It is taught by academics who are teaching, or have taught, at universities around the world.

Students who successfully complete all requirements are awarded the Wollaston Certificate in Theology, and may be eligible for entry into postgraduate studies at Murdoch University (see page 5).



Units

The Wollaston Certificate consists of eight units:

Core units

- Introduction to the Old Testament
- Introduction to the New Testament
- Introduction to Christian Doctrine
- Introduction to Church History

Elective units: pick four

- Ethics
- Anglican Studies
- Liturgy
- Ecotheology
- Youth Ministry
- Other units may be available, including the option to undertake a specialist reading unit in an area of particular interest (subject to availability of supervision)

You can complete all requirements of the 8 units, or audit as many units as desired.


